RoHS Compliance Statement

This letter certifies that materials supplied by The Electric Materials Company (TEMCO) comply with the Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) requirements as defined in Directive 2002/95/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council, dated January 27, 2003.

Limits are interpreted as:

- Lead* $\leq 0.1\%$
- Mercury $\leq 0.1\%$
- Cadmium $\leq 0.01\%$
- Hexavalent chromium $\leq 0.1\%$
- Polybrominated biphenyls (PBB) $\leq 0.1\%$
- Polybrominated diphenyl ethers (PBDE) $\leq 0.1\%$

*Copper alloys may contain up to 4% lead by weight as stated in Item 6, Annex section of Directive.

Lead is only added to comply with the chemical requirements of copper alloys C83450, C92200 and TEMCO 204. However, the lead content does not exceed 4% in these alloys. Mercury, cadmium, hexavalent chromium, PBB and PBDE are not intentionally added to TEMCO products nor used in the manufacturing process.
